How to play a Quota Tournament

In this game each player of a four-member team plays their own ball throughout the tournament. The game is played in stroke play using a Stableford or modified Stableford scoring system.

For this tournament the scoring will be

- 0 pt. For double bogey and above % $\label{eq:constraint}$
- 1 pt. for a bogey
- 2 pts. for a par
- 4 pts. for a birdie
- 8 pts. for an eagle

If a players next shot is for a double bogey, **pick up** and score a double bogey (0 pts.) for that hole.

Each team will be given a pre-determined quota based on the teams combined handicap index. All four scores are counted on each hole to determine the points for that hole.

Example- Player 1 par =2pts Player 2 bogey = 1pt Player 3 birdie= 4pts Player 4 dbl. bogey = 0pts Total points for that hole = 7 The combined points for all 18 holes is your team score.

The team coming closest, to or exceeding their pre-determined quota by the most points will be declared the winner. Second and third place will follow. In the case of a tie the score on the #1 handicap hole will be the tie breaker.
